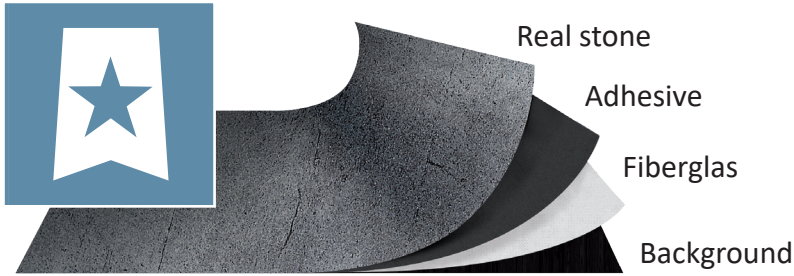


# CARE INSTRUCTIONS: SLATE-LITE

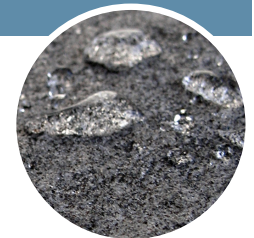
## CLEANING / CARE

Clean your *Slate-Lite* decors in everyday use with a lint-free cloth and normal tap water. The stone surface is simply wiped with a damp cloth. Commercially available cleaning agents can also be used, provided they are free of grease and oil. Refrain from using harsh detergents. Test any cleaning agent beforehand on a test piece or an inconspicuous area. If you use *Slate-Lite* as a floor covering, please wipe the surface with a damp cloth, similar to parquet floors, and avoid standing water.



## CALCIUM DEPOSIT REMOVAL

If you use *Slate-Lite* in wet areas and there are calcium deposits on the stone surface, you can remove these with commercially available cleaners (e.g. Cilit Bang). Carefully work in the cleaner with a brush and then rinse it off with plenty of clean water. Do not leave cleaner on the surface for too long. Test the cleaner you are using beforehand on a test piece or an inconspicuous area.



## GREASE STAINS

To remove oil and grease stains, please use the *Akemi oil and grease remover paste* available in our range. This can be used to remove even intensive dirt from the stone surface. For more detailed instructions, please refer to the relevant product data sheet.



## SCRATCHES

Scratches in the stone surface can usually be carefully sanded off. Use a sanding block or sandpaper with 150 grit for this. Before starting the sanding process, test your handling of the sandpaper on a test piece or an inconspicuous area. All available decors have been subjected to internal grinding tests, please contact us if necessary.
